MARINA EXCURSIONS



DEEP-SEA FISHING

The western edge of the Gulf Stream is approximately 30 minutes east of the Club, allowing for limitless sportfishing adventures. Dolphin, blackfin tuna, amberjack, wahoo, marlin and sailfish are some of the many trophy contenders that can be caught off our shores.

CORAL REEF BOTTOM FISHING

Numerous patch reefs are located within 20 minutes of the Club. Coral reef bottom fishing typically brings our anglers encounters with grouper, yellowtail, mutton and red snapper.



FLATS AND CREEK FISHING

It is only 10 minutes to the shallow flats, where bonefishing is some of the best in the world. Likewise, the mangrove-lined creeks surrounding the Club offer giant tarpon. Permit, trout, jack crevalle and snook also are frequent on the flats and creek areas, depending on the time of year. For a masterful experience, contact our fly fishing school.

SNORKELING

Exploring the shallow offshore reefs is an easily mastered and highly enjoyable sport. All necessary equipment is available at the Club as well as expert instruction.



SCUBA DIVING

Scuba diving, the ultimate underwater adventure, is available for certified divers. For guests who are not certified in scuba diving and wish to experience it, a one-day “resort” scuba experience is available with The Dive Shop at Ocean Reef.

WATERCRAFT RENTALS

Assorted watercraft rentals are available for use on the ocean including: 18’ and 24’ powerboats, sailboats, kayaks and stand-up paddleboards. Sailing lessons and guided aquatic tours are offered at an additional cost. Within the lagoon, small kayaks and paddleboards are available for children and families.



CRUISES AND CHARTERS

Another delightful activity is taking a fishing trip, day charter or even a sunset cruise aboard one of our specialty charter boats.

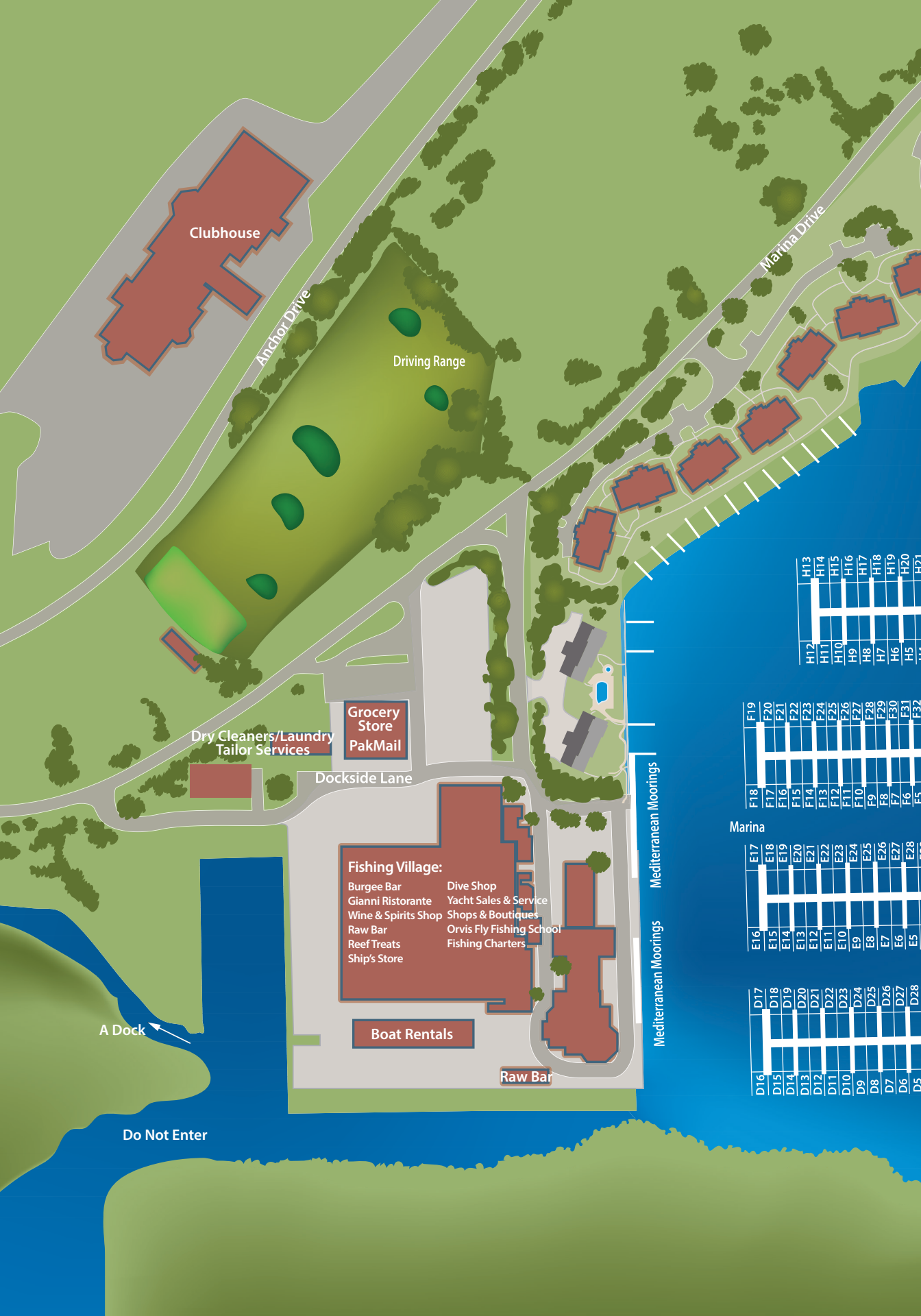
AMENITIES & SERVICES

WATERWAYS CHART – Suggested Approaches

The coordinates for the Ocean Reef Harbor head pin are N25°18'38" W80°16'45"

From the North Atlantic Side:

Approaching from Miami head south in Hawks Channel. Make a starboard turn towards Ocean Reef Harbor and set a heading for the head pin red marker #2 to enter channel.

From the North Bay Side:

Approaching from Miami on the Bay side head south in the intracoastal waterway. Make a port turn towards Angelfish Creek. Proceed through Angelfish Creek to the Atlantic Ocean. After which head southbound to the second channel south of Angelfish. Marker #2 Ocean Reef Harbor.

From the South Atlantic Side:

Approaching from Key Largo head north in Hawks Channel. Make a port turn towards Ocean Reef Harbor and set a heading for the head pin red marker #2 to enter channel.

From the South Bay Side:

Approaching from Key Largo on the Bay side head North in the intracoastal waterway. Make a starboard turn towards Angelfish Creek. Proceed through Angelfish Creek to the Atlantic Ocean. After which head southbound to the second channel south of Angelfish. Marker #2 Ocean Reef Harbor.

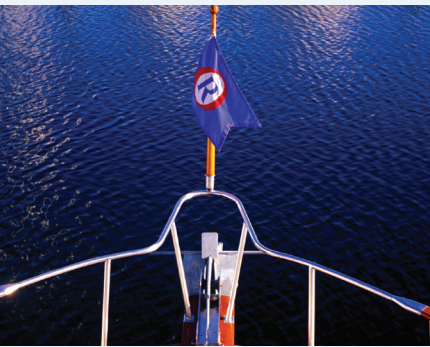
Be sure to always check the tides before entering or exiting the Ocean Reef Harbor and the surrounding waterways.

- Angelfish Cay mean low 4.5 ft.
- Ocean Reef Harbor mean low 6 ft. (Between Markers 5 & 6)



PARTICULARLY SENSITIVE SEA AREA
 The Particularly Sensitive Sea Area (PSSA) is indicated by a dashed green limiting line highlighted with a green screened band or by a green screened band used in conjunction with the line symbol for other limits with which the PSSA coincides. A PSSA is an environmentally sensitive area around which mariners should exercise extreme caution. See U.S. Coast Pilot volumes for information regarding this area.

GENERAL WATERWAY RULES



1. Boats will not be allowed to moor within the navigational channels of Ocean Reef Club.
2. No sewage, bilge or other nontreated water will be dumped in the surrounding channels and canals within the Ocean Reef Club.
3. Homeowners leaving boats on their private docks during hurricane season and times when they are not in residence will provide ORCA and Ocean Reef Club with the names of persons that will tend to the care and moving of those vessels should a storm warning be issued.
4. All Ocean Reef waterways are designated as “Minimum Wake” zones and speeding will not be permitted. The Ocean Reef Marina is a designated “No Wake” zone.
5. No seasonal liveaboards will be allowed in the single-family residential areas of Ocean Reef.
6. Offensive boat names will not be tolerated.
7. Because of the delicate environment surrounding Ocean Reef, vessels will not be allowed to fuel from fuel trucks in order to prevent possible fuel spills in the area.
8. Ocean Reef Emergency Services will ticket or arrest anyone operating a boat in the Ocean Reef waterways while under the influence.

For Added Convenience During Your Stay...

HOLDING TANK PUMP-OUT SERVICE

Complimentary pump-out service is available. Please call the Dock Office at Ext. 7740 to make arrangements for pump-out.

REFUSE

“Garbins” (garbage bins) are located at the head of each pier, and all bagged garbage should be placed inside them for pickup. The Dock Office staff will be happy to furnish you with garbage bags, should you require them.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS DISPOSAL

Please do not cause any hazardous materials to enter our waters. To dispose of hazardous materials, such as fuel, oil, and fuel and oil filters, please call the Dock Office at Ext. 7740 to arrange for pickup.

SECURITY & CLEARANCE

In addition to the security provided by Ocean Reef Club Public Safety, our dock personnel verify the identity of all boat traffic coming into the Marina and perform on-site inspections of all registered vessels. The Ocean Reef Community Association maintains a highly trained Fire Department to respond to all emergency situations.

CLUB AMENITIES

BUCCANEER ISLAND

This is a perfect spot at the Club to enjoy a refreshing libation and casual lunch while soaking up some of our famous Florida Keys sunshine. For simply relaxing, there are chaise lounges and umbrellas by the pools. Cabana rentals are available through the pool desk and include chairs, towels and bottled water. Buccaneer Island is also the Club's hub for aquatic sports activities. Get out on the lagoon or ocean in a rental watercraft. Our rental fleet includes sailboats, kayaks, windsurfers, stand-up paddleboards, and more.

GOLF

As golf clubs go, Ocean Reef Club's traditions go back more than half-a-century to 1955, when the first 9-hole course opened. Today the Club boasts two 18-hole courses, a rarity in the Florida Keys – even among standard golf clubs. Although the Hammock Course and the Dolphin Course offer distinctly different tests of golf, both feature scenic vistas and an enjoyable challenge for players of all levels.

TENNIS & GAMES CENTER

The Ocean Reef Tennis & Games Center offers 10 courts in total, six of which are lit for evening play as well as six Pickleball Courts. Upstairs from the Tennis Pro Shop you can join in on weekly games of bridge, canasta, mah jongg and more in our Card & Games Room. The Tennis & Games Center also offers a full-size grass croquet court.

PRIVATE AIRPORT

CLUB DRESS CODE

The Dress Code has been a long standing and cherished tradition of Ocean Reef Club. The standards of dress are by direction of the House & Grounds Committee and in the rules as designated by the Board of Directors.

CELLULAR TELEPHONES

Use of cell phones in any of the Club's restaurants and Fitness Centers is not permitted.

DINING ATTIRE

The required attire for gentlemen in all restaurants is best described as Club Casual – collared shirts and dress trousers in the winter season and equally appropriate attire for ladies. Shorts, if worn, must be of walking length. Smart long denim jeans are allowed in all of our outlets, with the exception of The Ocean Room during dinner service, and CH Prime. Sport coats are required in the Members-only CH Prime during the winter season and are appreciated but not required on gentlemen for dinner in The Ocean Room.

HEADWEAR

Gentlemen are expected to remove their hats whenever entering a Club facility, excluding the Raw Bar and Fitness Centers, where headwear is acceptable. Wearing baseball-style caps backwards is not acceptable in any Club area.

RECREATION ATTIRE

Cut-off, unhemmed and tattered jean shorts are not allowed. Each recreational area also has dress requirements, as shown at right:

GOLF

Golf courses and Driving Range require collared shirts for men (no mock turtle necks) and appropriate golfing shorts (no cargo or athletic shorts). Sleeveless golf blouses with collars are permissible for ladies, as is other appropriate golfing attire. Golf shoes must have non-metal spikes and shirt tails must be tucked in at all times.

TENNIS, PICKLEBALL & CROQUET

Tennis requires appropriate tennis clothing and footwear. Short and long tights must be covered. Pickleball permits fitness attire and footwear. Gentlemen's shirts must have sleeves. All-white attire must be worn on the Croquet Courts. Swim trunks and cotton t-shirts are not permitted.

BATHING ATTIRE

One- or two-piece bathing suits that provide appropriate coverage are acceptable. Bathing coverups, as well as footwear, must be worn in all areas away from the beach and pools on Buccaneer Island. Athletic-style tank tops are permitted for men on Buccaneer Island.

FITNESS CENTER & OUTDOOR EXERCISE

Shirts must be worn for jogging, walking and other forms of exercise within the community. All shirts worn by gentlemen within the community must have sleeves or if sleeveless, must be hemmed. Ladies' shirts must have full coverage. Proper athletic footwear is required in the Fitness Centers.

The Club's standards of dress are required for all Members and guests over 12 years of age. Thank you for your assistance in maintaining the cultured family environment of the Club.
